1. PROVISION OF CHILD'S NEEDS

(Describe the main needs of the child and how they are being met in the moment of the study, indicate what needs to be done, what has (not) been done since previous report.

HEALTH: Physical development – height, weight, problems and they are solved, annual health check, vaccinations.

EDUCATION: success/achievements, problems and their accordance to age, type of educational institution, extra education/classes/tutoring.

DEVELOPMENT of the child's SKILLS: access to games, clubs, sports, additional education

APPEARANCE of the child and how is the child adopting to social demands: if the child is dressed according to his/her age, gender, culture, religion; how is the child's personal hygiene, what is the child's behavior in various circumstances, does the child response adequately to his/her adoptive parents' advice.

SELF-SERVICE SKILLS: if the child is able to dress him/herself, eat without anybody's help, solve social and everyday problems.

2. CAPABILITY OF ADOPTIVE PARENTS TO MEET CHILD'S NEEDS

MAIN CARE: Feeding, accommodation, clothes, hygiene, medical and dental care (if parents are able to meet these needs)

PROVISION OF CHILD'S SAFETY: how is the child protected from danger – no access to dangerous items (i.e. electricity, medicines, gas; dangerous people, etc.); how do the parents evaluate the child's safety.

EMOTIONAL CONTACT: how do the parents show their attachment to the child; necessary physical contact, comfort, emotional attachment.

3. FAMILY AND ENVIRONMENT

FAMILY HISTORY: how does family history of adoptive parents influence the child – who lives in the house and how does it influence the child, has there been any changes in the family; what are some family traditions; how would you describe the relationship with relatives and within the family.

SOCIAL CONTACT OF THE FAMILY: with neighbors, friends, acquaintances, teachers, care providers, does the child have regular contact with other kids of his/her age.

PLACE OF RESIDENCE.

LIVING CONDITIONS: how big is their house/apartment, does the family rent or own; conveniences; how would the family describe their housekeeping – (good, satisfactory, unsatisfactory); any additional info on home and financial issues.

WHETHER THE CHILD HAS his/her own room, bed, places to play, toys, and books; does the child follow a daily schedule to eat and play/study.

WORK: who in the family works and who doesn't, changes in work-schedule and how it influences the child.

INCOME: Average/Above average/Below average. Is the family financially able to provide for the child (i.e. clothes, footwear, toys, school supplies, payments for clubs, school, other expenses).

RESIDENCE RESOURCES: does the family have access to educational, medical, cultural institutions, transportation, etc. – give examples

CONCLUSION:

1. Overall how is the child doing and what else needs to be provided (in regards to: the child's needs, capability of parents to meet the child's needs, family and environment) and what parents need to do to make necessary changes.
2. Does the family feel they need some extra help and who's going to provide it.
